Roquebrune-sur-Argens consists of three complementary areas, each offering its own way to experience the destination.

The Rocher

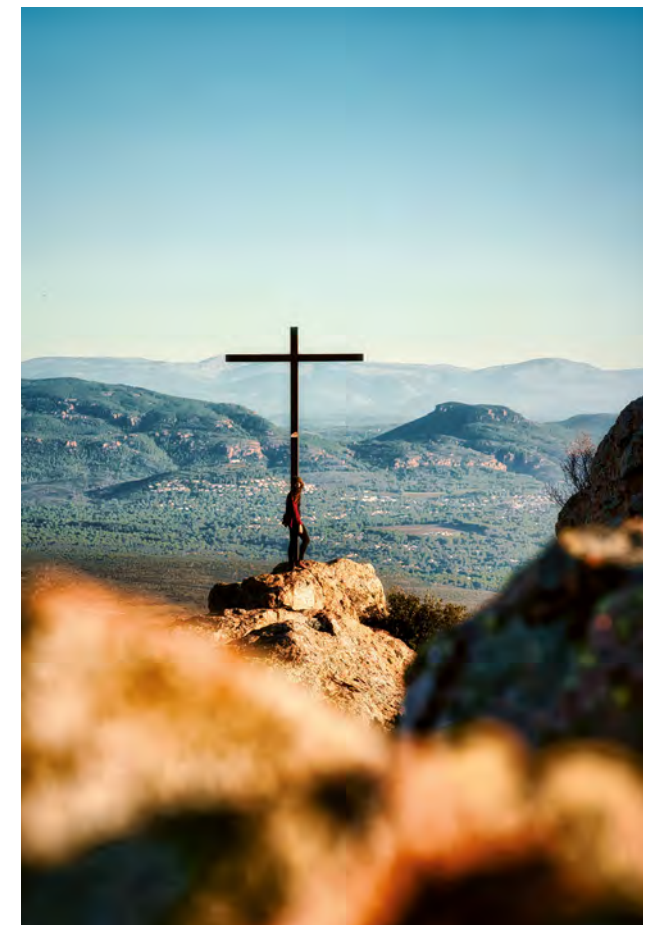
You can see it from far away. The Rocher de Roquebrune stands out in the landscape, its ochre-red silhouette serving as landmark for locals and visitors alike. Soon comes the moment to slow down, breathe deeply and begin the climb at your own pace.

The trail climbs upwards, winding its way between oak trees, rocks and the fragrant scents of the garrigue. Gradually, your steps find their rhythm and the walk begins to feel natural. The light plays on the stone, revealing changing shades from deep red to warm copper. From time to time, you pause just long enough to admire a rock formation, a twisted root or an unexpected view.

Little by little, the scenery unfolds. Below, the Argens river winds its way through the landscape, the hills stretch out and, on the horizon, the Mediterranean Sea appears.

A peaceful silence settles in, inviting you to breathe differently.

Up there, there is no victory to celebrate. The Rocher is not a summit to conquer, but a place to pause, observe and simply take in the moment. On the way down, one feeling remains: the sense of having experienced something simple and essential, a moment that makes you want to return again and again.



Between Argens and Lac Aréna

“A breath of fresh air”

Follow the water's edge to discover another, more intimate side to the destination. In places, the river widens, gliding beneath lush green vegetation, shelters herons, European bee-eaters and delicate insects. Here, the water sets its own pace: calm, steady and soothing.

The Lac Aréna offers a completely different atmosphere. A peaceful setting, almost mirror-like, surrounded by wooded banks where the wind plays in the foliage.

Side by side, these two natural settings tell their own story and together shape a truly distinctive landscape.

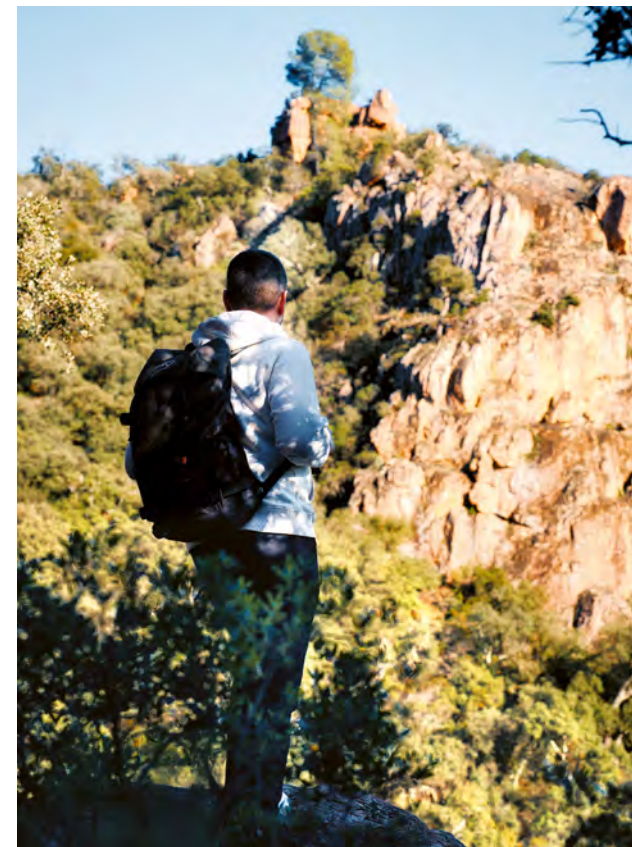

Shhh... with a little luck and patience...

Nature sometimes reveals itself: a motionless heron, a discreet turtle basking in the sun, a grass snake crossing the water, the ballet of dragonflies or the blue flash of a kingfisher.

These fleeting encounters are precious moments, to be observed with respect at all times.

The Blavet, the power of minerals

The red rock rises high and sculpted by time. Nature surrounds you with a striking mineral landscape and steep vertical walls. Roots creep into the cracks, shrubs grow where you would least expect them, and pine trees cling to the cliffs as if refusing to let go.

The trail alternates between narrow passages, cool shaded areas and rocky basins where wildlife finds refuge, before opening onto sweeping views across the valley. Hikers follow their way through this Mediterranean forest where birds of prey glide silently above the cliffs.

This rugged landscape is a must-see. It's easy to understand why so many walkers and climbers come here to recharge.

Meet the sea at sunrise

At dawn, standing on a paddleboard or sitting in a kayak, you glide across a perfectly smooth surface, far from the noise and crowds. Your paddles trace the first lines of the day. The sun rises, setting the horizon ablaze and catching the light on the water. The shore slowly fades behind you, your body awakens, your mind unwinds.

Here, the day begins differently: facing the open sea, with the feeling of being in the right place at the right time.

When the mimosa blooms

From late January to February, the Vallon de la Gaillarde undergoes a remarkable transformation. Mimosa trees burst into golden blossom, lighting up the entire valley. Brief but spectacular, this fragrant and luminous flowering offers one of the most beautiful winter walks in the region.

Vallon de la Gaillarde, winter light and hidden forests

In winter, soft light filters through the oak trees, gently lighting the cliffs and revealing the subtle colours of the Mediterranean landscape. The Vallon de la Gaillarde first leads through gentle woodland before revealing a dazzling view of the Mediterranean and the Petites Maures hills.

Here, everything feels quieter and more spacious. As if nature were slowly reclaiming its place.

Between cool shade, narrow passages and sun-drenched viewpoints, the walk feels intimate and peaceful. This valley is best explored outside the summer season, when the landscape reveals its true character.

Coastal trail

“A seaside escape”

Walking along the coastal trail means staying close to the sea, where the terrain sets the pace. The path winds along a ribbon of rock and sea air, alternating between steep sections, coves and panoramic views of the open sea. At every turn, Mediterranean vegetation accompanies your walk: wind-shaped pines, sea fennel, immortelle flowers...

Along the way, you may also come across discreet traces of the past, such as the Gallo-Roman fishpond, blending discreetly into the landscape.

Botanical trail

In the heart of the Maures forest, the Roquebrune-sur-Argens botanical trail invites you to enjoy a gentle, sensory stroll. Over a distance of 2.3 km, the path winds through pine trees, arbutus trees and mastic trees, lined with engraved stone slabs identifying the plant species. Light filters through the foliage, while the scents of resin and warm earth accompany every step.

Easy and accessible for families, it is also an opportunity to discover nature and viewpoints, including the aqueduct of 25 bridges as a fascinating historical feature.

Good to know

- Sturdy walking shoes are recommended, as the rocks can be uneven and sometimes slippery
- In the event of heavy swell or strong winds, access may be unsafe: check conditions before setting out
- Please respect the fragile coastal flora and fauna

Roc d’Azur CIC, where challenge meets wilderness

Every autumn, the Roquebrune-sur-Argens area comes alive: the Roc d'Azur CIC arrives, bringing thousands of mountain bikers, and outdoor enthusiasts. The event creates a unique atmosphere, transforming the landscape into a vast playground. Hosting one of Europe's biggest mountain biking events means opening up its trails, hills, coastline and iconic Rocher to athletes who come to push their limits.

Here, cycling takes place against a spectacular backdrop: ridges overlooking the Mediterranean and wilder landscapes where the garrigue scrubland reigns. The terrain itself becomes the challenge: demanding, yet deeply inspiring.

Roquebrune-sur-Argens finds a natural resonance here: a sporting DNA, contrasting nature, a rare ability to combine effort, beauty and disconnection.

The Roc d'Azur CIC is a complete, raw, authentic playground that appeals to both athletes and riding enthusiasts.

During the event, the town lives to the rhythm of bikes: special accommodation, restaurants fill with riders, entertainment, meetings and moments of relaxation by the lake or the sea.

Many return after the competition to explore the trails in a different way, for example by hiking, just for pleasure and above all to share the experience with their families.



If you dream of flying over the water, in the most literal sense of the word, **Issambres Kite School** opens up a world of possibilities.

Wing-foil, kitesurfing and electric foil: here, you can learn to take off, glide and work with the wind and water. Coaching is precise: students are constantly supervised from a boat, making progress reassuring and sensations immediate. You will discover a new relationship with the sea, one of lightness, balance and freedom.

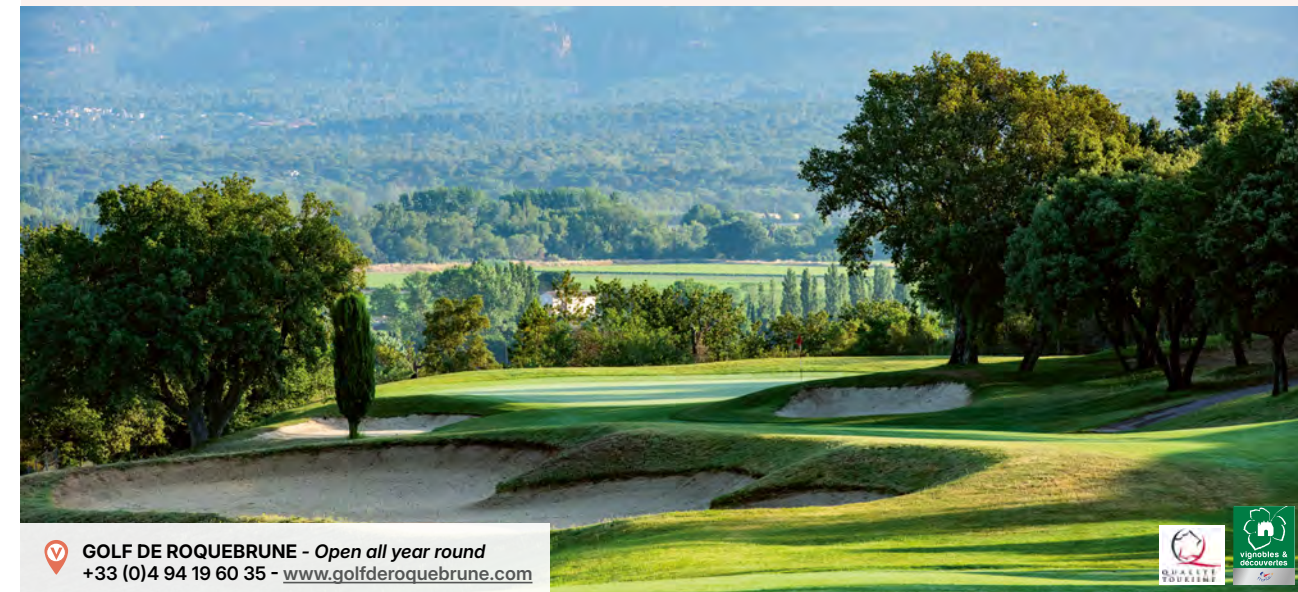

“Lachens à la Mer” Crossing

What makes the “Lachens à la Mer” mountain bike race unique is its rare route from the ‘foothills’ to the Mediterranean Sea.

The race starts at Mont Lachens, the highest point in the Var at 1,715 metres above sea level, offering a panoramic view stretching to the Mediterranean sea.

Then the descent begins: high-altitude forests, the valleys of the Pays de Fayence, scrubland and red rocks. Over nearly 90 kilometres, the landscape constantly changes as riders make their way down towards the sea. The arrival at Les Issambres marks the end of the route, with the sea finally coming into view. Leaving the mountains behind to reach the sea in a single race is an experience that is as physical as it is unforgettable.

They protect fragile soils and plants.

Observe without disturbing

The wildlife reveals itself best in silence.

Keep the site clean

Everything you bring with you should leave with you.

Preserve tranquillity

Respect sensitive periods: flowering, nesting, protected areas.

Before you set off

Choose a suitable route

Take everyone's fitness level into account. Children have short legs: plan breaks and be prepared to turn back if necessary.

Inform someone about your hiking plans

Let someone know your route, departure time and estimated return time, especially if you are hiking alone.

Plan your route

Consult the GPX track or the step-by-step guide in the walking guide to anticipate the terrain and duration.

Check the weather

Remember to check the weather forecast in the previous days: heavy rain can make the ground muddy. Avoid high temperatures.

Secret beaches and coves

Between sandy curves and small rocky coves, the coastline reveals a more intimate Mediterranean. The coastal path leads to secluded spots, perfect for spreading out your towel and enjoying a quiet moment away from the bustle.

In the morning, the sea is often as smooth as glass.

At midday, the salty air accompanies long swims in the sun, while the afternoon invites you to take a nap and relax to the sound of the waves. As the day comes to an end, the temperature softens, the sky turns shades of gold and pink, and swimming becomes a truly peaceful experience.

Each beach has its own character: fine sand, pebbles, rocky headlands, small hidden coves... Some are designed for families, while others remain deliberately wild to preserve the natural charm of the coastline.

A unique diversity, ideal for varying your pleasures and enjoying a real sense of freedom in a privileged part of the Mediterranean.



The local way of life...

Morning team

A local arrives before anyone else, while the beach is still untouched. Ten minutes to settle in: the water as calm as a mirror, then a silent dive: this is his way of greeting the day.

Swimming alone, accompanied only by the sound of the waves. One of the simple pleasures of life here.

Evening Team

After work, head to the sea. An impromptu game of beach volleyball with friends, a paddleboard session from the beach, then one last swim as the sun begins to set. A picnic overlooking the sea, laughter mingling with the sound of the waves.

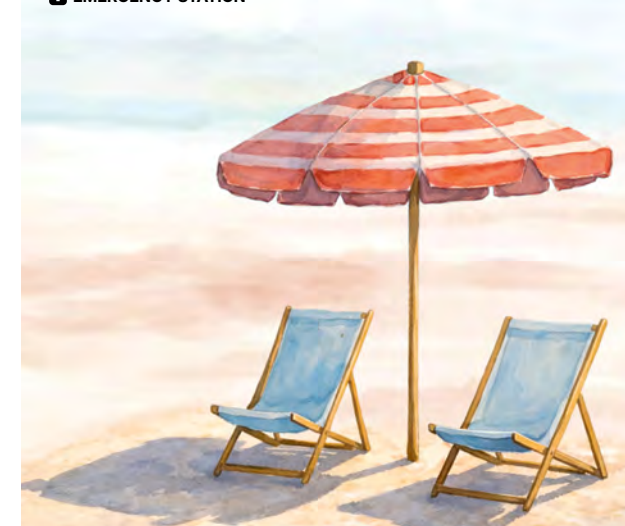

Exploring the Argens with La Base du Rocher

Fresh water, nature and freedom

“Canoeing or kayaking down the Argens River is a chance to enjoy a trip far from the turmoil of the sea, close to nature and tranquillity”

Located at the foot of the Rocher de Roquebrune, **La Base du Rocher** offers several routes to explore the river. You can choose your route: a gentle introduction along the Rocher de Palay, perfect for children aged 4 and up, or a more challenging trip to Lac Noirel, and for the more adventurous, an excursion combining river and sea for children aged 7 and up. Every outing is professionally organised, with a briefing, suitable equipment and careful launching. The team at **La Base du Rocher** ensures both safety and a relaxed, friendly atmosphere.

The magic of the place lies in the fresh water winding its way along banks alive with wildlife that often appears around the bend, nestled in the shade of the abundant vegetation that thrives all year round in this wetland environment, the river reveals a rich natural setting. Look closely, you may see herons, dragonflies, turtles, fish... All signs of a thriving ecosystem. Some guided tours combine walking with biodiversity awareness, a great way to mix adventure with respect for nature.

Canoe, kayak or paddleboard: choose how you want to discover the Argens from a close-to-nature perspective, full of surprises, just a few paddle strokes away.

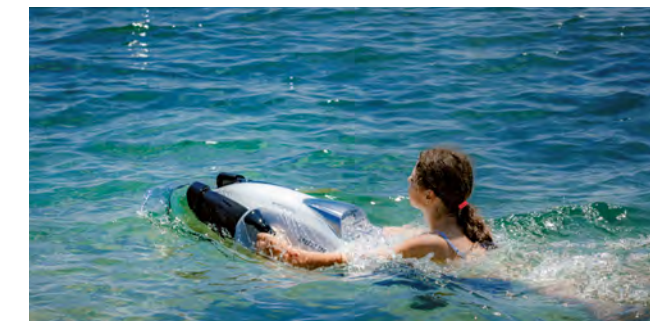

An unspoilt coastline

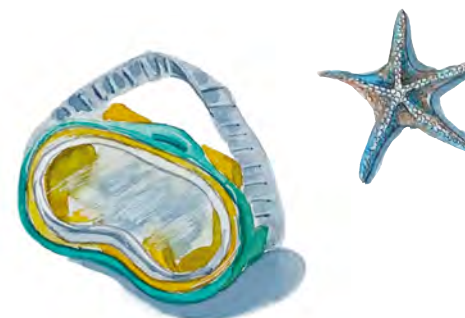
Gently sloping beaches, secluded coves accessible on foot or by sea, and crystal-clear water that immediately makes you want to dive in.

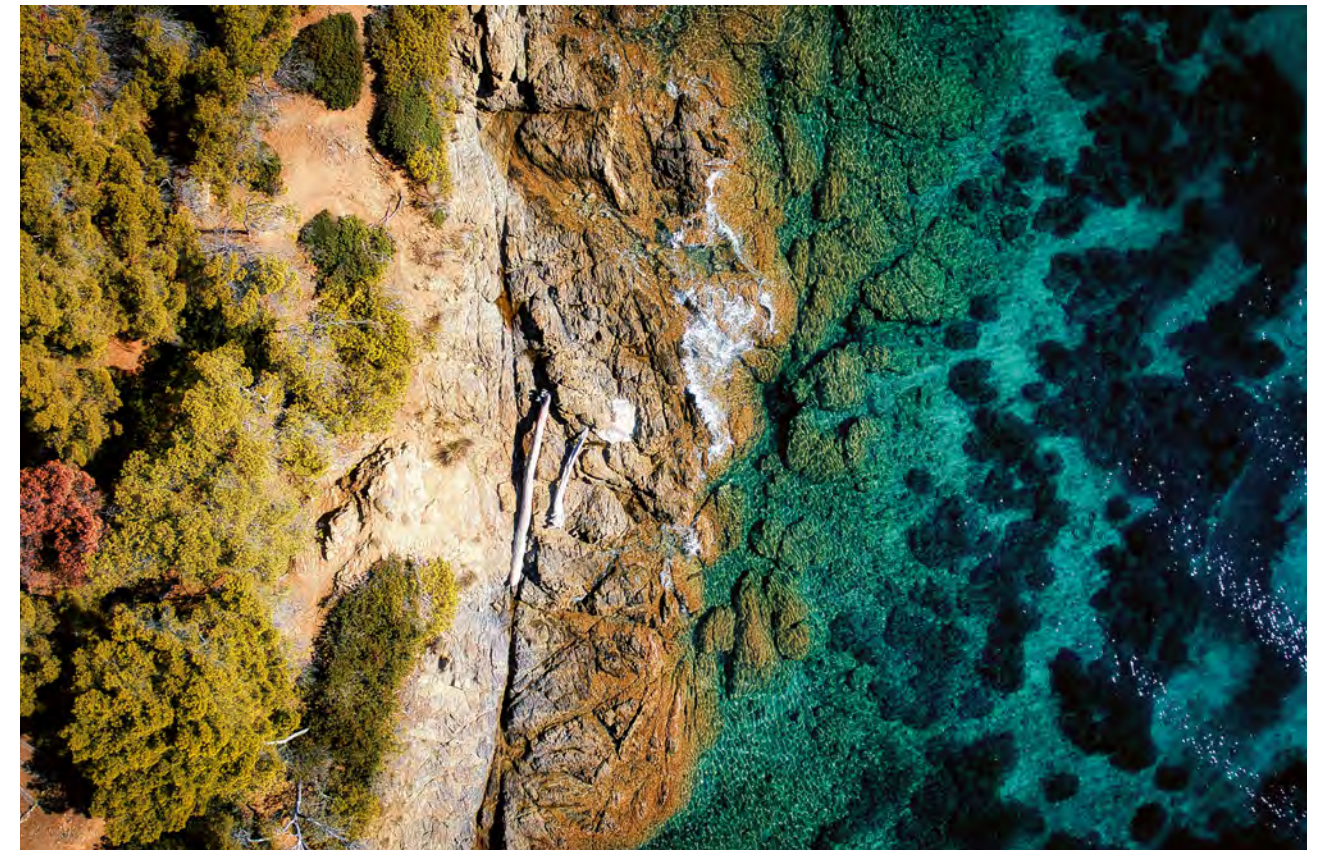
Snorkelling trail

Meet at the Calanque Bonne-Eau

At Calanque Bonne-Eau, the discovery begins the moment you put your head underwater. This recently created underwater trail blends naturally into its surroundings. Accessible by swimming, it offers a self-guided and discreet way to observe and understand marine life without disturbing it. Underwater educational panels placed along the route guide your gaze: here a Posidonia seagrass bed and further on the discreet passage of a curious fish.

The site highlights the richness of local species and the fragile balance of the Mediterranean seabed. The principle is simple and essential: observe, learn, do not touch.

Depending on the light, the season or the time of day, the scenery changes. One day, the water is clear and bright; the next, it becomes more mysterious.. A life-size aquarium, alive and ever-changing, transforming a swim into a sensory and educational experience.



For diving enthusiasts...

Scuba diving reveals a more hidden side of the Mediterranean. Local spots offer varied rocky seabeds, crevices and seagrass beds, that shelter rich marine life: wrasses, groupers, octopuses and silvery shoals. Visibility is often excellent, making every dive clear and spectacular.

Posidonia, underwater treasure

Often mistaken for seaweed, *Posidonia oceanica* is an essential marine plant. It oxygenates the water, stabilises the seabed and is home to incredible biodiversity. Found in Les Issambres, it is strictly protected: it is observed, respected and never pulled up. It is a valuable indicator of the good health of the Mediterranean.

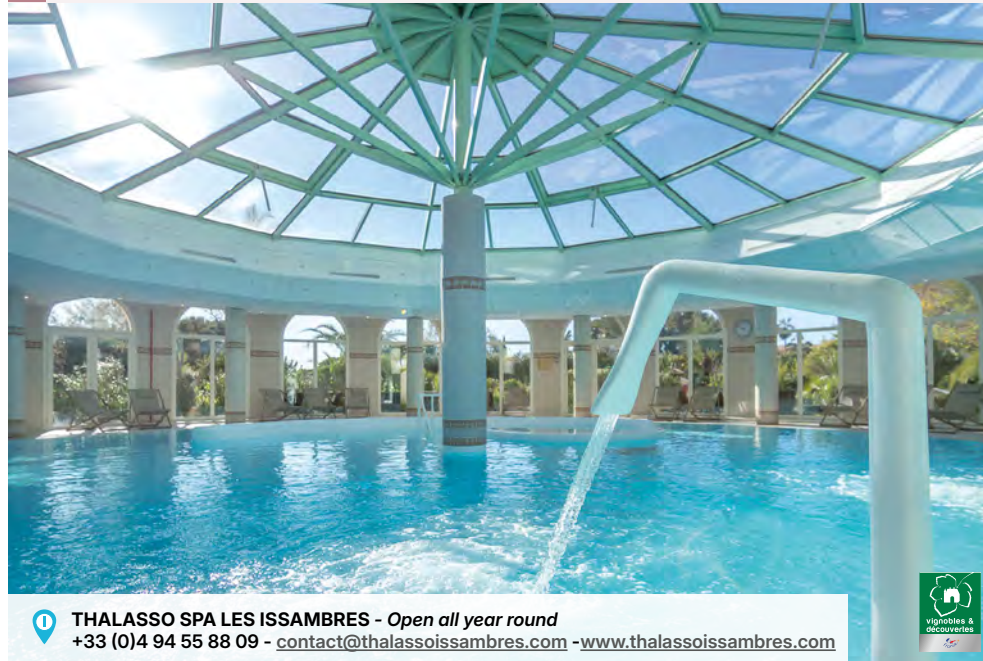

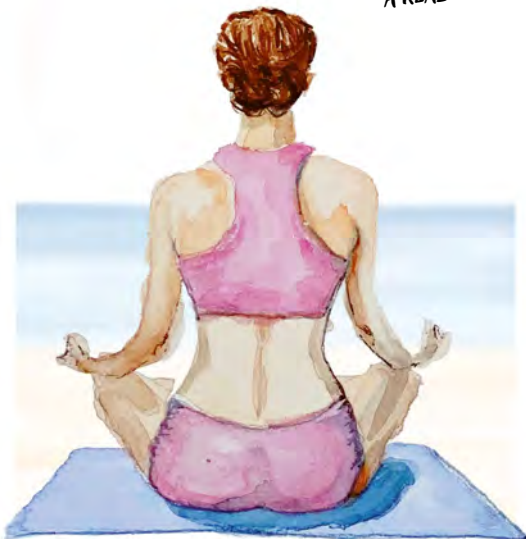

The medieval village

Roquebrune-sur-Argens first reveals itself through a striking silhouette: that of the Rocher, an immense mineral presence watching over the village. At the foot of this natural sentinel, the medieval village unfolds through a labyrinth of narrow streets, stone archways shaped by time and small sunlit squares.

You will naturally find your way heading towards the clock tower, Rue des Portiques and Le Portalet, all fragments of history scattered throughout the village's daily life.

A unique atmosphere

Here, everyone knows one another... residents chat in front of old doors and greet shopkeepers. Children run down the stairs, and Place Perrin comes alive. You'll feel like stopping for a coffee and letting yourself drift into the gentle rhythm of the village, where time seems to slow down.

Welcome to a village that doesn't try to impress, but simply and sincerely tells its story.

And that's precisely what makes it unforgettable.





La Maison du Chocolat et Cacao, a well-kept secret

[House of Chocolate and Cocoa]

Housed in the former chapel of the Sisters of Charity of Nevers, carefully restored while preserving its original 17th-century vaults, this unique place reveals an entire world devoted to cocoa. Tucked away in a quiet alleyway, you might easily walk past without imagining that this former chapel now shelters a remarkable chocolate collection. Beneath its historic vaults, you will discover a collection of antique boxes, vintage moulds and retro advertising posters: a true cabinet of chocolate curiosities.

You can freely through the museum. Children hurry towards the wonder ‘choco-mômes’ area, the curious linger in front of an Art Deco advertisement, while others admire the silhouette of a chocolate bar mould from another century.

The charm of this place lies in its harmony: a simple and welcoming space that invites you to slow down and take your time.

As you leave, closing the door feels a little like shutting a treasure chest, with the delightful sense of having uncovered a secret known only to those who took the time to look for it... and perhaps with a sudden urge to enjoy some fine chocolate at one of the village’s artisan chocolatiers.

Not to be missed

A true gem for lovers of vintage curiosities: an antique advertising automaton. An absolute rarity, with only two examples listed in France, ours being the only one that still works as it did in its heyday.

[House of Prehistory]

The Maison de la Préhistoire opens a window onto thousands of years of history. Located in La Bouverie, it displays objects discovered at nearby prehistoric sites. Visitors can see tools, pottery fragments, reconstructions and educational displays that reveal the daily lives of the region’s earliest inhabitants.

This fascinating stop offers a different way of looking at the natural world around us: no longer as a backdrop, but as the first refuge for the people who lived here long before us.

The short and intuitive visit is suitable for all ages and makes an ideal introduction before exploring the surrounding trails.

Gallo-Roman fishpond, a journey into Roman times

On the Mediterranean coast, almost at sea level, the Gallo-Roman fishpond at Les Issambres stands out for its remarkable state of preservation. Carved into the rock and protected for centuries, this basin was once used to keep fish alive for the preparation of the Romans’ favourite dish: garum, a sauce similar to nuoc-mâm, made from fish entrails.

As you approach, you can still clearly see the basins and low stone walls forming channels that allowed water to circulate through a cleverly designed system. It is one of the last remaining submerged fishponds in the Mediterranean.

This listed site can be explored freely: a simple rocky outcrop is enough to take you back nearly two thousand years.

The Five Chapels Walk

“Where stone and light guide your way”

Exploring the chapels and churches of Roquebrune-sur-Argens is a journey through the village's stone, light and quiet atmosphere.

At the northern entrance to the village, the Saint-Roch Chapel blends into the colours of the Rocher and the banks of the Argens. Its ochre silhouette greets visitors and recalls the ancient link between the village and its ancient routes of passage. At times, concerts or exhibitions reveal the peaceful atmosphere of the place.

On Place Perrin, the Saint-Michel Chapel reflects the village's collective memory. Once connected to the municipal cemetery, it now overlooks daily life and occasionally comes alive during cultural events.

Set apart and surrounded by scrubland, the Sainte-Anne Chapel leaves a lasting impression with its soothing setting, an invitation to contemplation.

A must-see!

Focus on the Parish Church of Saint-Pierre-Saint-Paul



In the heart of the village, the imposing façade of the parish church of Saint-Pierre-Saint-Paul appears as you turn a corner. Listed as a historic monument, this Gothic-style building was constructed in the 16th century on the remains of the original 11th- and 13th-century church. Behind the ancient wooden doors lies a nave adorned with remarkable works of art, illuminated by daylight streaming through the stained-glass windows.

Outside the old town centre, the Saint-Pierre Chapel, a Romanesque gem and the oldest in the municipality, stands with a sober and timeless presence.

In Les Issambres, built in 1960, the Chapelle des Dolmens is an open-air chapel composed of four stone pillars supporting a roof of old tiles. Discreet and peaceful, it houses an altar and a beautiful stone statue of the Virgin Mary.



Maison du Patrimoine

[Heritage Centre]

“Simple and discreet, the Maison du Patrimoine invites visitors to step directly into the history of the village as it once was”

In the heart of the medieval village, the Maison du Patrimoine is one of those places where history reveals itself naturally. Visitors stop here to discover Roquebrune-sur-Argens from a different perspective, through ancient traces that tell the story of life in times gone by.

From the terrace, the view of the Rocher is breathtaking.



Inside, a collection of 18th-century ex-votos bears witness to beliefs and gestures of gratitude.

One of the most striking discoveries is the village's former ice house. Once covered by a stone dome, it was used to store ice before selling it to surrounding villages as far away as the Gulf of Saint-Tropez. It's easy to imagine the work of the villagers: the back-and-forth trips, the winter cold carefully preserved underground so it could last through the summer.

A taste of Provence: traditional stuffed vegetables

Born in the farmers' kitchens of Nice and widely embraced across the Var countryside, stuffed vegetables tell a simple yet proud story: that of generous seasonal cooking where nothing is wasted and everything is elevated.

Originally, summer vegetables from the garden were stuffed: sun-ripened tomatoes, round courgettes, small peppers and sweet onions were filled with a mixture of minced meat, fresh herbs (parsley, thyme and sometimes basil), garlic, egg and breadcrumbs soaked in milk.

Every family has its own secret recipe. Some add a little extra garlic, others a pinch of Parmesan cheese, and sometimes there's even a 100% vegetable version.

The dish bursts with colour, like a Provençal market set out on the table. It's shared at Sunday lunch, straight out of the oven, still piping hot!
